



5 Fun Things to Tell Your Kids About the Swedish Midsummer Celebrations!

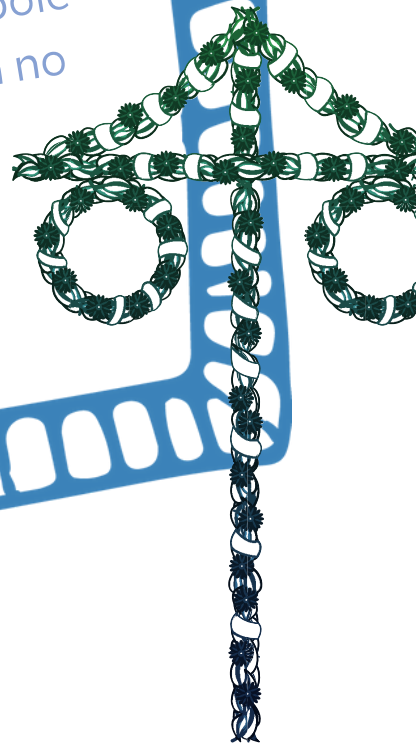

ears! Yes, it's really true!



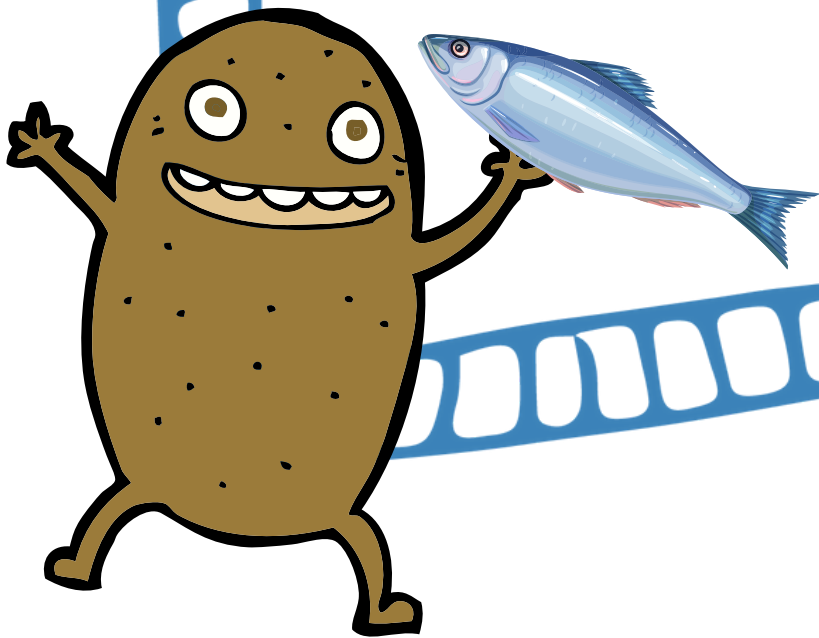
**Om man plockar sju sorters blommor och
